Membership:

Marines (active, reserve, retired and former) as well as Navy Corpsman of like kind are solicited to join. Associate Membership is available as well. The cost of membership is \$30.00 annually; this provides you with a MCL magazine, information and representation by the National Headquarters in matters of interest to us all at the governmental level.

Meetings:

Regular meetings are conducted the first Tuesday of each month at 1900 hours in the VFW Clubhouse located on Mumford Road (near River Park North). Special meetings and Committee meetings are scheduled as needed.

Home Away from Home Fund:

We provide financial and other assistance to family members of injured active duty military service personnel, from ALL branches, receiving medical care at Pitt County Memorial Hospital. We also provide support to active duty families with a baby admitted to the neonatal intensive care unit.

Every year, dozens of active duty service members are transferred to Pitt County Memorial Hospital to be treated for life threatening injuries. Many of the family members of these service members travel hundreds of miles to be with their loved one and are unfamiliar with Eastern North Carolina.

Our mission is to provide some comfort and stability during this difficult time by providing a shoulder to lean on and in some cases financial assistance. Our vision is to provide a "Home Away from Home"

Toys for Tots:

The detachment, as of 2008, is responsible for collecting and distributing thousands of toys to needy children in Pitt County and other counties each year. This takes MANPOWER and cooperation which only we can provide as a Detachment.
